

PROPOSAL FOR SUPPORT

1. Summary

Saikripa is a non-profit registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860 in Noida, Uttar Pradesh functioning since 1988 for the welfare of the parentless and underprivileged children. The shrinkage of non-renewable resources is happening very fast and is forcing the mankind to find other sources of power that are renewable. Hence, Saikripa would like to explore the possibilities of harnessing power through solar energy. Besides, this will make sizeable savings in the expenditure against power consumption.

While complying with the CSR norms and mandates this can play a great part in sustaining the Environment. The project will approximately cost Rs. 3,59,210.00 (Rupees Three Lakhs Fifty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred and Ten only)

2. Introduction to your NGO - Qualifications of the Organization

Saikripa is a non-profit registered society functioning since 1988 in NOIDA for the welfare of the parentless and underprivileged children & youths of the Society. Our main activities are:

- **Balkutir**- Homes for the children for different categories of age.
- **Sai Shiksha Sansthan**- a co-educational, English medium Secondary school with a strength of 420 children in the village Wazidpur, NOIDA.
- **Sai Bal Sansar & Sai Vatsalya Vatika** - a free non formal education centre for the street and slum children with a strength of around 220 children, having a separate unit for special children. Midday meal is also provided.
- **Sai Vocational Training Centre** – Imparting training in Tailoring, Bakery, Beauty culture, Computer & Spoken English to around 200 youths and women from underprivileged society of NOIDA.

Saikripa beneficiaries are abandoned, parentless and underprivileged children, youths and women from slums and villages.

Balkutir, a Home for about 65 abandoned children facilitating shelter, food, health care and education in NOIDA (U.P.) since last Thirty years. Apart from every year around 100 children who are brought to Saikripa for temporary shelter are restored to their parents/guardians or transferred to different homes according to their needs.

Over these thirty years more than 550 children have successfully been restored to their parents/guardians. More than 20 inmates have become self-sustained by way of employment, seven girls are married and living happily.

3. Project Background or Rationale - Problem Statement or Needs Assessment

This support will serve more than three thousand children in a span of about 25 years. Lots of children who are abandoned or less privileged have no home available in NOIDA either run by government or any suitable private body who are willing to readily admit the children under any

conditions/circumstances. Hence, the necessity of Balkutir, a home for these kinds of children where these children are readily taken in without any hesitation.

4. Priority Area of Funding as per Schedule VII of Section 135

Funding will be as per the activity vi mentioned in the schedule VII of Section 135 of Companies Act, 2013 i.e. Ensuring environmental sustainability.

5. Program Goals & Objectives

The goal of the program is to provide facilities such as home, clothing, healthcare, education, etc. to the parentless and underprivileged children to enable them to become independent in the course of time. The support sought is for providing solar panels in the Balkutir- Home for girls (11 to 18 yrs.) and for children (0-10 yrs.) of Saikripa. This will very much go into harnessing of natural energy sources that will maintain the environment conducive to the nature.

6. Methodology

This will make some savings in the cost of power utilised in the homes apart from the green energy source. The cost is likely to get recovered in a span of about five years by way of above mentioned savings.

7. Timelines & Milestones

The work connected with the provision of solar panels in the homes will take about two months from the date of receipt of funds. This will benefit around 50 permanent inmates, 50 temporary children living in Balkutir totalling to 100 beneficiaries as far as the utility of electricity on different aspects. This is estimated to last for twenty-five years.

8. Beneficiaries and Impact

The beneficiaries will be the inmates of Balkutir, in Sector-12, NOIDA Uttar Pradesh and the impact will be their progress in their growth with regard to studies, health, and other achievements. This will have a great positive impact on the environment.

9. Monitoring and Evaluation Plan

The support will be monitored and evaluated at different levels such as program officer, executive director and board members.

This particular item of work for which support is being sought doesn't involve much evaluation so far as the functioning of the solar panels is concerned. However, the benefits accrued due to the usage of solar panels can be evaluated by way of progress of the inmates of balkutir on

various aspects such as their education, healthcare on quarterly basis by the wardens, program officer and executive director.

10. Any other support for the project

For the project of provision of solar panels at Balkutir, there is no other support as of now.

11. Sustainability Plan

As far as the different kinds of sustainability is concerned such as organisational, financial and community, we need not worry at- least for another twenty-five years for solar energy.

12. Budget

Net Project Cost will be Rs. 3,59,210 (Rupees Three Lakh Fifty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Ten only)

13. Conclusion

This support will greatly help Saikripa in harnessing renewable energy from solar panels apart from the savings in our expenditure against consumption of power on a long term basis.

The savings accrued through this could be spent on more developmental ways for the children.
