Proposal: Sai Bal Sansar (SBS) is an informal education centre, a project of Saikripa functioning since 1999 imparting basic education and computer skills to the children from underprivileged/ marginalized families in and surrounding vicinity of Aghapur villages, Sector-41, NOIDA apart from the children of Bal Kutir residing under the care and protection of Saikripa's home project 'Bal Kutir'. The children are also provided with mid-day-meals.

The strength of SBS in the current academic year is about 170 students. The total expenditure estimated is around Rs.30,00,000/- per annum which primarily includes rent of the school premises followed by honorarium of the teachers & trainers, internet, stationery, fuel and power consumption.

Purpose: The children living in and around village Aghapur have no access to education at the appropriate age due to poverty, their parents being migrants/labourers and depending on daily wages for survival. Thus, education is given the least priority by their parents. Sai Bal Sansar is dedicated to counselling such families and promotes education for their children. The Centre provides free education intending to assist children make their way into mainstream education bridging the gap matching to the suitability of their age.



Reasoning: Many children were able to successfully complete their schooling and get admission into mainstream schooling.

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
