Proposal: Support to Sai Vocational Training Centre run by Saikripa

Saikripa is a non-profit organization registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860. The organization has stepped into its 36th year of functioning towards the upliftment of abandoned and neglected children and marginalized youth of society.

The projects are being run in Childcare, Education & Skill Development and Training. The names of the existing projects are as under:

- 1. **Bal Kutir:** Shelter for parentless and abandoned children, currently catering to more than 80 children.
- 2. Sai Bal Sansar: An Informal Education centre for street and underprivileged children from urban villages. With a unit functioning for especially abled children
- 3. Sai Vocational Training Center: Skill development centre for marginalized youth and women.

Description of the Project for which Support is needed:

Sai Vocational Training Center (SVTC) came into action on 30 April 2010 with a mission to transform the lives of several marginalized youths and women. The purpose of SVTC is to instill life skills education in the children and the youth from not-so-privileged sections of society and assist them in achieving a sustainable life.

Since then, we have successfully trained and helped more than 1000 beneficiaries have picked up jobs by upgrading their skills. The skill training housed Computer Proficiency, Spoken English Tailoring, Bakery & Cooking, and Beautician on a highly subsidized fee.

Confidence building and spoken English have been integrated with all the courses offered at SVTC. The aim is to school every individual not only in the basic skills of their interest but to also make them confident individuals to face the Public.

The candidates catered to are from the age group of 14 and 35 years, mostly, school and college dropouts/ too impoverished to pursue higher education.

Purpose of the Proposal:

Sai Vocational Training Center focuses on upskilling the youth and women from marginalized sections of Society. Here it is ensured that every student enrolled need support.

Training is imparted in various job-oriented vocations namely, Spoken English, Computer Skills, Tailoring, Bakery and Beautician courses, which are in demand and always have been the preferred. The whole aim is to promote sustainability.



In addition to the jobs the students attain knowledge, and confidence in addressing the public, learning the skill to deal with the challenges of life. Certain awareness programmes are imparted as a part of the course curriculum which helps these students to be safe from prevailing cybercrimes and be mindful of self-behavior and the surrounding environment. The students are also exposed to mock interviews and public speaking, which helps them in getting jobs.

To continue running this project, trainers with appropriate skills are required.
